OREGON DERMATOLOGY SOCIETY MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES 2012

ACTIVE MEMBERS: \$300.00

Physicians licensed to practice in Oregon or neighboring states and who are Board eligible or Board Certified dermatologists, having the **degree of MD or DO**, meeting the criteria of the American Board of Dermatology or the American Board of Osteopathic Dermatology. Dues for Active Members shall be designated in the Administrative Regulations. Active members may attend monthly meetings of the Society.

REGIONAL ACTIVE MEMBERS (out of area): \$150.00

Regional members shall meet criteria for Active members, **degree of MD or DO**, but are not expected to attend monthly meetings of the society, but shall retain the right to do so. To be eligible for out of area status, the member must reside at least 50 miles from the OMA building located at 11740 SW 68th Parkway, Portland, OR 97223. Dues for Regional Active Members shall be designated in the Administrative Regulations. Regional Active Members may attend monthly meetings of the Society. A fee may be assessed when attending a Society social or meal function.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERS: \$150.00

Professionals with advanced **degrees of MD, DO, PhD, DDS, DMD, DVM** with special training in dermatology or dermatopathology who are not eligible to be active members of the Society. Associate members shall have all the rights of active members except they shall not have the right to vote or hold elective office. Associate members shall be required to pay annual dues equivalent to half the annual dues of active members. Dues for Associate Members shall be designated in the Administrative Regulations. Associate Members may attend monthly meetings of the Society. Associate Members shall be required to pay for any social activities they attend.

EDUCATIONAL AFFILIATE MEMBERS: \$300.00

Dermatologic **Physician Assistant (PA) or Dermatologic Nurse Practitioner (NP)**, employed by and under the supervision of active ODS member. Maintains an unrestricted license in OR and/or WA. Has been associated with and worked under the supervision (as defined by applicable OR or WA State Law) of an active member for at least one (1) year. Has submitted application and letter of recommendation from the active member with whom he/she is associated. Letter should set forth nature of the supervisory relationship between ODS member and applicant. To maintain status, Educational Affiliates must show evidence of continued employment/supervision by an active ODS member. This must be done on yearly basis, and may be done by responding to a written inquiry from ODS. Response must be signed by Educational Affiliate and ODS member employer. Failure to respond within 3 months shall result in automatic termination of Educational Affiliate status. If Educational Affiliate ceases to be employed by or under supervision of ODS member, Educational Affiliate status is automatically terminated at that point. Educational Affiliates shall not have the right to vote or hold office. Dues for Educational Affiliate Members shall be designated in the Administrative Regulations. Educational Affiliate Members may attend monthly meetings of the Society.

REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL AFFILIATE MEMBERS (out of area): \$150.00

Shall meet criteria as above (**PA or NP**), but are not expected to attend monthly meetings of the Society, but shall retain the right to do so. A fee may be assessed when attending a Society social or meal function. To be eligible for out of area status, member must reside at least 50 miles from the OMA building located at 11740 SW 68th Parkway, Portland, OR 97223. Dues for Regional Educational Affiliate Members shall be designated in the Administrative Regulations.

RESIDENTS-IN-TRAINING MEMBERS: \$-0-

(MD/DO) Residents-In-Training Members may be eligible for membership, pending: Must be recommended by Chair of the Department of Dermatology-OHSU, or designated Residency Director. They will be exempt from dues. They may have the privilege of the floor, but may not vote or hold office. Residents may attend monthly meetings of the Society.

RETIRED---INACTIVE MEMBERS: \$-0-

Active members who have retired prior to age seventy (70) or are incapacitated by reason of illness, accident or infirmity and who, for this or any other reason, are unable to engage in active practice of dermatology, and members who are called to temporary active duty with the Armed Forces, and members who have left the geographical area encompassed by the ODS, may be elected to Inactive Membership. Period of Inactive Membership shall be determined by a majority vote of the membership committee and may be extended if necessary. Inactive Members shall not be required to pay annual dues. They may attend scientific and monthly meetings. They may be required to pay for social activities. Inactive Members shall not be entitled to vote or to hold office in the Society, but shall have the privilege of the floor of the Society.

LIFE MEMBERS: \$-0-

Any person who has continual membership in the Society for a minimum of ten (10) years and who has attained age seventy (70) years, may on application to the membership committee, and approval of a majority of society members, be classified as a Life Member. Life Members shall be entitled to vote, but may not hold office, but shall have the privilege of the floor of the Society. Life Members are relieved of annual dues and may attend scientific/monthly meetings and may be required to pay for social activities.
